**CORBETT ACCEL HEALTHCARE GROUP ANNOUNCES
RETIREMENT OF COMPANY'S *FIRST* EMPLOYEE**

CHICAGO, November 30, 2006 — After more than 40 years with Corbett Accel Healthcare Group, Jeri Dowling, Director of Media, has announced that she will retire at the end of the year to spend more time with her family. Dowling is one of the first employees hired by the company's founder, Frank J. Corbett.

"I accept this news with great sadness for our firm," said Scott D. Cotherman, Chief Executive Officer of Corbett Accel Healthcare Group. "I have great admiration for everything Jeri Dowling has seen, heard, and influenced for more than four decades with our company,"

Dowling started with the company in December 1961. "Frank Corbett called the school I went to and asked one of the nuns for one of their best students," she recalled. "I answered the call and I've been here ever since."

As the agency expanded, Dowling's professional contributions grew with it. Literally, she worked her way up from using mimeograph machines to becoming the company's media director. During her tenure, Dowling has seen the company grow from three individuals to more than three hundred people today. Corbett Accel is now one of the largest healthcare communications companies in the U.S., with a client roster of blue-chip companies that include Alcon, Bristol-Myers Squibb, Merck, Genentech, GlaxoSmithKline, Procter & Gamble, Roche, Sanofi-Aventis, and Wyeth, among others.

When asked if there was anyone who asserted a significant impact on her career, Dowling cited Frank J. Corbett as “my guiding force, giving me my first opportunity, believing in me, challenging me to do better, and to aspire to higher roles in the agency.” She said, “He always built confidence in your ability to take on more responsibility.”

Inasmuch as Mr. Corbett inspired her, Dowling continues to inspire others with her professionalism. Cotherman is particularly moved by Dowling’s gesture to impart her wisdom in retirement to future generations by increasing volunteer work at her local library upon her retirement.

“She is a living legend in our industry and has made a great many friends both within and outside the agency during her time here,” Cotherman said, adding, “It would be an understatement to say that Jeri has educated many account executives and space representatives about the ins and outs of media planning and placement.”

The company has yet to name Dowling’s replacement, but Cotherman said the company is planning to give Dowling a “proper send-off” at year’s end. The event will be held on November 30, 2006 to coincide with Corbett’s 45th anniversary—and 45 years to the day Dowling joined the company.
